COLPIS was established in 1989 with the aim of providing guidance and support to professionals in political science and sociology.

One of the main objectives of COLPIS is to promote innovation and modernisation of public administrations, encouraging collaboration among diverse actors (public administration, universities, NGOs, etc.) to address main challenges in public governance and administration.

- 1 state level contract
- 7 regional contracts
- 1 county contract
- 25 local contracts
- 4 other public administrations (universities, research centers, etc.).
- □ 31 contracts fall within the province of Barcelona, 1 in the province of Girona and 1 in the province of Lleida.
- 5 contracts cover all Catalunya area

THE IMONITOR PROJECT IN CATALONIA



Short list of contracts to be monitored – Criteria:

- Main criterion: Opentender integrity indicator
- Additional criterion: Anti-Fraud Office's red flags.



MAIN PROFILE OF MONITORS



- University students
- People who work in public administrations
- People linked to local/neighborhood communities
- People without previous knowledge in public administration interested in corruption
- □ People representing a diverse age range (20 to >60).
- □ 32,3% of monitors are women

MAIN ISSUES IDENTIFIED DURING MONITORING



- ☐ To conduct an in-depth review of contracts requires a significant dedication of time, which is not always available to supervisors.
- ☐ Lack of public information about the execution of the contracts
- Lack of answer from the public administration or delays in providing the information.



SUCCESSFUL STORIES



■ Strong collaboration among COLPIS, OAC and O3C







- Combination of the Imonitor methodology with the OAC indicators
- High rate of people who completed the training modules
- 100% satisfaction rate with the content of the training modules
- □ 15,8% of the contracts monitored reported some irregularities
