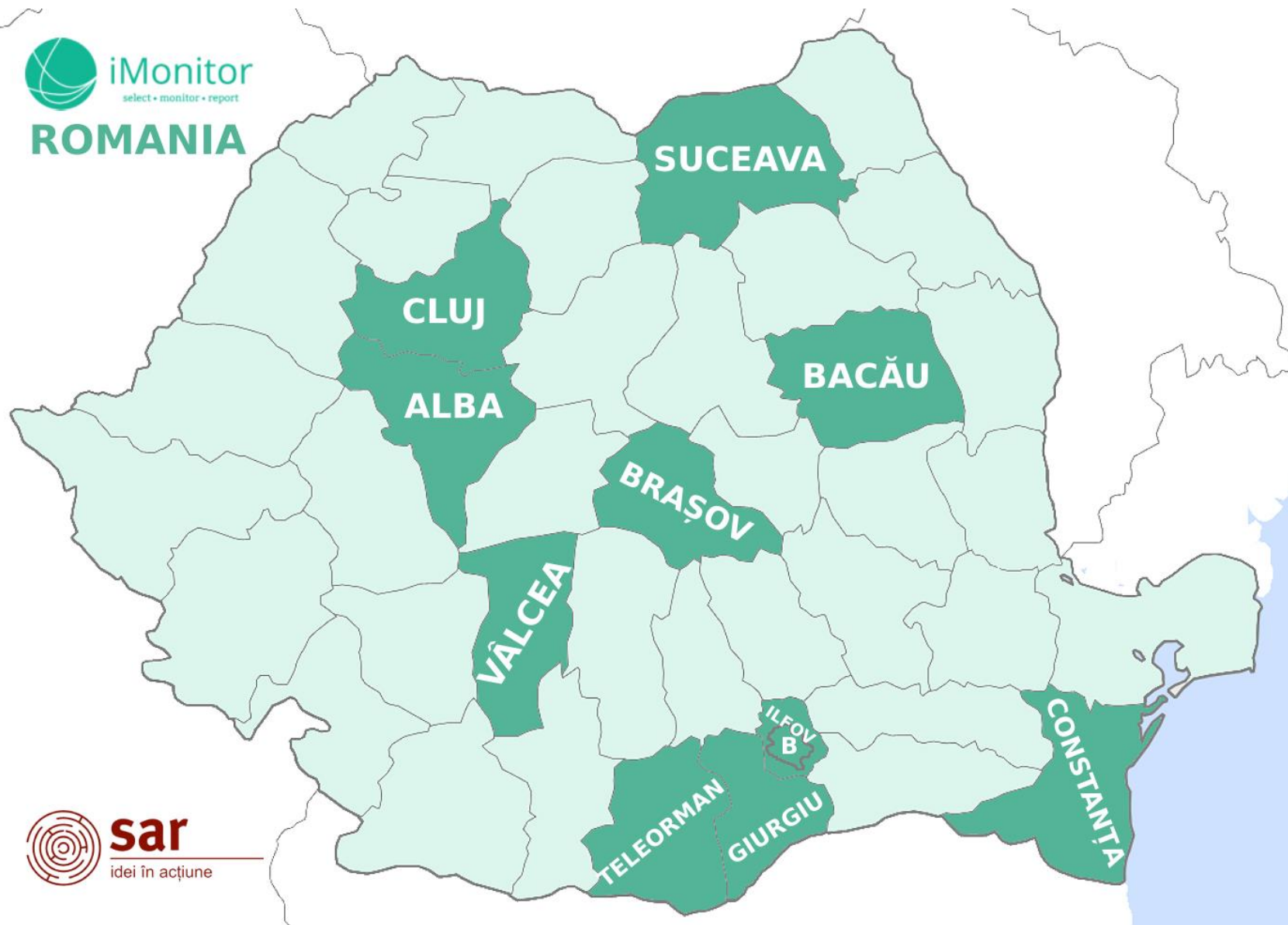

Summary

- Monitoring of contracts and asset declarations
- Grassroots approach
 - 15 individual civic monitors (36 initially)
 - 89% satisfaction rate
 - Mostly young, mostly first-time monitors
- Training-based approach
 - 3-4 individual training sessions (contracts)
 - 1-2 individual training sessions (asset declarations)



Contracts

- 10 counties + Bucharest
- Monitored contracts
 - Total - 26
 - 4 no documentation
- Reports submitted
 - Full – 11
 - Pending – 15
- On-site visits:
 - 10 done
 - 4 pending
 - 4 reminders
 - 8 N/A

Case studies

- Braşov Zoo
 - Supplied complete documents
 - Agreed to on-site visit
 - Presented implementation in-depth
 - Passion and vision
- The Nutella case
 - No documents
 - No visit
 - Corruption charges



Asset declarations

- 13 volunteers
 - Group and individual training
- 1145 collected
 - All towns and cities
 - The largest communes in each county
- Analysis pending
